## Seeking Information on Suspect Vehicle in Robbery

On Sunday, January 19, 2014 at approximately 11:15 p.m. Milan Officers responded to a report of a robbery at Arby's on Dexter Road. Officers met with an employee from the business who stated a male subject came in the back door, displayed a knife, and demanded money. Some money was obtained that had not yet been secured in the safe. Access was reportedly gained through a rear door that had a self latching lock attached that could only be opened from inside with the push bar. The employee was approached just before leaving for the night after another employee and the other employee's friend exited the back door. Officers checked the door and it appeared to be functioning properly. There was no sign of forced entry. A Police K-9 Unit was summoned to the scene and did not locate any sign of a suspect or track. No one was injured. There have been no similar incidents reported in the area.

**Suspect Description:** Light complexion, black male, early 20's, 5'-7", wearing a blue stocking cap, black pants, black sunglasses, and something covering his mouth.

After significant follow-up, Milan Officers have concluded the incident occurred as reported and the victim has been completely cleared of any involvement.

The investigation has revealed that this was not a random incident, there was more than just the individual involved who confronted the victim, and there appears to have been familiarity with this location and its operation.

Persons of interest have been identified. Search warrants have been obtained and served. Laboratory analysis of evidence seized is currently underway and results are expected shortly. Milan PD was able to locate surveillance video from a resource in the area. That video was received earlier this week and after review and analysis, a suspect vehicle has been identified. We are working with other area law enforcement agencies searching for that vehicle and are requesting the public's assistance, as well.

## **Suspect Vehicle: Silver, 2000 Chrysler, LHS**

Attached are photos of the suspect vehicle at the location at the time of the robbery. In addition, in the center is a photo of a similar make and model for reference.
