SUMMARY OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS CITY OF MILAN

BEAUTIFICATION COMMISSION:

The purpose of the Commission is to study and develop plans for beautification of the city streets, highways, alleys, utility installations, parks, streams, playgrounds, yards, lots and buildings to encourage and recommend the placing, planting and preservation of trees, flowers, plants, shrubbery and other objects of ornamentation in the City of Milan and make recommendations regarding community projects.

BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY:

The purpose of the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority is to promote the revitalization of environmentally distressed areas in the city, whereby the Authority is authorized to capture tax increment revenues to assist a property owner or developer in the assessment, Prevention and clean up existing contamination.

BUILDING & SAFETY BOARD OF APPEALS:

The main function for the Building and Safety Board of Appeals is to hear appeals from citizens regarding building code decisions from the Building Official. This board is the only body that can grant exceptions to the building code and override an interpretation/decision of the Building Official. The decisions are often final but may be appealed to circuit court for further consideration.

DOWNTOWN DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY:

The main function of the Downtown Development Authority is to promote the economic growth and increase property tax valuation in Milan by attracting and retaining business and industry into the city and by enhancing the appearance of the downtown business district to promote investment and reinvestment.

ELECTED OFFICERS COMPENSATION COMMISSION:

The Elected Officers Compensation Commission was created to establish a mechanism and procedure for determining the salaries for the elected officials of the City of Milan.

MILAN BUILDING AUTHORITY:

The purpose of the Milan Building Authority is to construct and/or acquire building, parking lots or structures, recreational facilities and the necessary sites for the use by the city. The Authority oversees the construction, administration, and leasing.

PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION:

The purpose of the commission is to advise City Council of the activities and facilities relating to Parks and Recreation, developing a comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan and update as needed, as well as presenting proposed projects and programs and evaluating and reporting public response thereto.

Recent projects

1. Update of Parks & Recreation Master Plan (completed 2/2001)
2. Improvement and enhancement of facilities in the Parks and Recreation Program.

PLANNING COMMISSION:

The purpose of the Planning Commission is to review applications for major types of construction projects and developments and ensure that each project complies with the requirements of the zoning ordinance. The Planning Commission also assists and makes recommendations to the city council on various issues including the development of the zoning ordinance and the master plan.

POLICE COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD:

The purpose of the board is to act as a official liaison between the Police Department and the community of Milan; to keep the community informed, as well as make comments and recommendations regarding policies, programs and conditions at the Police Department; make relevant information known; encourage community interest and involvement in the Police Department; assist the Police Department with community relations projects; and take such actions as may be appropriate to accomplish the objectives of the board.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS:

The purpose of the zoning board is to consider applications for variance to the zoning ordinance and to decisions of the zoning official. The zoning board of appeals has the authority to override decisions of the zoning official and interpret the ordinance. Decisions of the ZBA can only be appealed through circuit court.
