### ***Yard Waste***

Yard waste includes grass clippings, leaves, weeds, spent plants, corn stalks, straw and brush less than 2 inches in diameter only (pumpkins and gourds should be placed in the trash). Yard waste is picked up the first Tuesday in April through the third Tuesday in November. Yard waste must be placed in a Kraft paper bag or 32-gallon or less, containers labeled with a yard waste sticker and not weighing more than 50 pounds. Place at the curb, at least ten feet from the rubbish and recycle bin. Yard waste stickers are available at City Hall at no cost.

### ***Brush Chipping Service***

The City of Milan offers curbside brush chipping services to city residents. The chipper is scheduled to go out daily from April through September. There are certain regulations that must be followed in order for brush to be chipped. The regulations are as follows:

- Branches, limbs, etc must be 4 inches in diameter or less.
- Brush must be neatly piled behind the curb with the cut ends facing the street. Do not pile brush in the street. City crews will not access private property to gather brush. Piles that are not neat and orderly will not be picked up.
- Material must be free of nails or wires or other debris attached
- No vine plants or materials (i.e. grape vines, poison ivy vines, etc) as it may damage the chipper. Vines may be cut smaller and placed in yard waste containers for general curbside yard waste pickup.
- The amount of brush is limited to 6 cubic yards, or a pile 9 feet long by 4 feet wide by 4 feet deep.
- Material to be chipped may be placed at the curb only 3-4 days prior to the scheduled chipping date (typically the weekend before the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the month). Piles that are placed out too soon or too late will be required to be removed from the curb side until the next scheduled pickup date.
- The chipper will only service a street once per scheduled chipping date, so please be prepared. Check the City's website and Facebook page for updates on scheduled chipping dates.
